God Acts upon our Faith (Discussion Questions)

1. In the story of Jesus feeding the 5000, Jesus said, "You give them something to eat." What did He mean? The disciples had nothing. (See Mark 6:30-44)
2. In the next story in Mark 6, he tells his disciples to go across a lake. A storm comes and they are terrified. What did Jesus mean "they had not understood about the loaves." (See Mark 6:51-52)
3. In another account, Jesus takes them across a lake and another storm. The disciples say, "Don't you care if we drown?" Jesus said, "Why are you so afraid? Do you still have no faith" The disciples said, "Who is this? Even the winds and waves obey Him? (See Mark 4:35-41)
What are some processes that God take us through to learn faith?
