3. 1 John 3:16-18 We know how Jesus laid down his life for us. How are we to lay down our lives for one another?
4. Colossians 3:12-14. How do we “clothe ourselves” with these qualities? How do we “put on love,” which binds us together in unity?
5. Galatians 5:22-23 The “fruit” of the Spirit is love. If love does not characterize our lives as Christians, then God IS NOT IN CONTROL. How can I grow in this fruit of the Spirit?
